

WEATHER FORECAST IN VIEW OF CYCLONIC STORM "TITLI"

Wednesday 10 October 2018

10 October (Day 1):

- ◆ **Heavy to very heavy rain at a few places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places** very likely over Odisha.
- ◆ **Gale wind speed** reaching 100 -110 kmph gusting 125 kmph prevails over deep Sea areas of west central and adjoining north Bay of Bengal and very likely to increase gradually to 120-130 kmph gusting to 145 kmph from today evening; Gale winds speed reaching 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph is very likely to commence along Odisha coasts from today afternoon. It is very likely to increase gradually becoming 140-150kmph gusting 165 kmph along and off south Odisha from tonight and 70-80 kmph gusting to 90 kmph along and off north Odisha .**Squally** ◆
- ◆ **High to phenomenal Sea Conditions** are likely to prevail over above mentioned areas. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

Thursday 11 October 2018

11 October (Day 2):

- ◆ **Heavy to very heavy rain at a few places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places** very likely over Odisha.
- ◆ Storm surge of height of about 1.0 m above astronomical tide is very likely to inundate low lying areas of Coastal Odisha.
- ◆ Phenomenal Sea Conditions are likely to prevail over above mentioned area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.
- ◆ **Gale wind speed** over deep Sea areas of west central and adjoining north BOB and very likely to increase gradually to 120-130 kmph gusting to 145 kmph from today evening; Gale winds speed along and of Odisha coasts are very likely to increase gradually becoming 140-150kmph gusting 165 kmph along and off south Odisha and 70-80kmph gusting to 90kmph along and off north Odisha .

Friday 12 October 2018

12 October (Day 3): ◆ **Veavy to very heavy rain** at isolated places over Odisha .

- ◆ **Phenomenal Sea Conditions** are likely to prevail over above mentioned area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.
